## **The Roeder Rant**

5 +1 turn full RH & retain hand hold [2] 1+5+3 set. (on the setL,5 rotates (Rsh back) to face S)

Lsh to 3, 5 dances ½ spine reel of 3 to end facing W.

- 9-16 Repeat bars 1-8 ...but with ... Lh turn with 4,the rotation Lsh back & 5 giving Rsh to 2 in the ½ reel across . 5( ends facing NW.)
- 17-24 All dance **R&L for 5\***, 5 dances LH tpot with W+S to begin. (5 dances back to the centre at the end & turns to face E)

\* R&L for 5 dancers ....see Index for full description.

The RH exchanges are identical to a 2c R&L, but the LH exchanges become

1/2 Tpots, with the centre.

25-32 Points petronella 1 pl clockwise & set; while....5 stands [4bar]

5 turns 3 1 ½ RH & both set while... other points stand

The foot-tapping music suggested was the inspiration for this dance. It uses simple familiar figures but needs a bit of stamina, balance and flight to be danced as well as it is played!
