## Bardill/Prince 2007 Dances for sets of 5 individual dancers

Reel 5,5,32,5 music "Sailor" by Jim Mcleod

## Reel of the Emperor's Egg

1-4 5 loops Rsh round N & returns to centre *White.....* corners adv (pasdebas), circle L 2 places & retire.

Note 1 (S) spins about at the end of bar4 so that 3,5&1 all face down on the spine

**5-24** all dance the "LongTrek":

The "Long Trek" portrays the southerly march of the penguins.

Each dancer skip-changes with hands down at sides as an individual and always dances S down the spine, turning L( to E) or R (to W) alternately, and setting to the centre at these points on the return to N.

Note after 20 bars, all dancers finish in their "start" positions (i.e. end B4)

25-32 Points adv to join in a shoulder to shoulder circle with 5 (who faces NW between 1 &4) [2 bars]
All 5 dancers retire with 1 moving to SW and 5 to SE [2 Bars]

All re-advance, 1 steps to centre & sets, While......All other dancers: Clap & petronella 1 place anti-clockwise

This dance portrays the surge out of the ocean on to the ice, the long,long march & the arrival of the egg. It's a really easy dance, once the trek sequence is mastered!
